Dr. Kelsey Morris is an Assistant Research Professor in the Department of Special Education at the University of Missouri (MU) and Co-Director of the MU Center for School-wide Positive Behavior Support (PBS).

Kelsey is a national scholar with technical assistance, publications, and research focused on positive behavioral interventions and supports, classroom management and evidence-based practices, targeted interventions, supporting students with disabilities, data-based decision making, and district-wide implementation of PBIS.



Dr. Morris is also a member of the Association for Positive Behavior Support (APBS) Board of Directors and serves as an implementation partner for the National Technical Assistance Center on Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) funded by the U.S. Department of Education and the Offices of Special Education Programs and Elementary and Secondary Education.
