

PBIS Team Member “Booster” Trainings

Applying Practices to Changing Educational Environments

Audience: The PBIS Team Booster Trainings are designed for school groups of two or more people including coaches, new or current team members, and/or administrators who are looking to strengthen current implementation. These sessions will explore how to apply PBIS practice and systems to changing educational environments. Networking and planning time will be provided for participants to address their current needs including virtual, blended and in-person.

Tier 1: Sessions will address the team's role in supporting the use of effective Tier 1 practices and effective decision making through strategic use of data. Teams will review and refine definitions and instructional practices, social, emotional, and behavioral skills, and expectations including environmental and consequence strategies.

Training dates: 11/17/20 & 11/24/20 or 1/6/21 & 1/13/21

Tier 2: Sessions will address the team's role in supporting the implementation of primary Tier 2 interventions (CICO, SAIG, Mentoring), how they are supported by defining 6 critical features, and how to ensure alignment with Tier 1/Universal practices.

Training dates: 12/9/20 & 12/15/20 or 1/28/21 & 2/3/21

Each training will run from **8:30-11:30 AM** each day and cost **\$130/ person**. Each Tier 1 and 2 booster session will be offered twice; choose one session to attend. These events will be virtual.

Note: New team members should attend with at least one other seasoned team member. A recent team self-assessment (i.e. SAS, BOQ/TFI) is required to attend.
