

TIER 1 VIRTUAL TRAINING SERIES

Outcomes

Learn and understand the evidence base and critical features necessary for successful implementation of the PBIS framework.

Create systems that focus on developing environments that foster a strong sense of community, identity and belonging for all stakeholders.

Examine and refine adult practices related to student behavior including prevention, teaching, and response strategies.

Practice systems level discussions about data that include problem identification and solution development.

Create a plan to lead, build purpose, train, and support staff and stakeholders, so that strong and sustained implementation happens.

Audience

Building leadership team that is representative of the school. Team members should include a building administrator (required), and a combination of family members, community partners, instructional staff, pupil service staff, support staff, and paraprofessional representation.

Cost

\$1600 per team/team of up to 8 members; each additional member \$200

Fee includes registration, technical assistance between training dates, materials and up to 6 hours of coaching support
