

Behavior Lesson Plan: Cool Tool

Universal Expectation: Students will understand the importance of resolving conflicts with out using physical aggression.

Skill/Setting: Conflict Resolution, Physical Aggression **Grade Level:** Intermediate (2-6)

PURPOSE OF LESSON (what do you want them to know)

The purpose of this lesson is to teach students the 6- step process to conflict resolution. Then allow them to depict it through drawing.

TEACHING TOOLS/RESOURCES/EXAMPLES

- 1) Play Script
- 2) Definition Sheet- "I" statements and conflict
- 3) Movie Reel paper

STUDENT ACTIVITIES (modeling/role play/lg, sm group/reading/writing)

- 1) Read Background information to students about conflict and conflict resolution
- 2) Ask students if they have seen or been a part of a conflict.
- 3) Discuss "I" statements
- 4) Read Play Script or Scripts
- 5) Allow students to draw a movie reel of 4-6 slides showing the proper way to solve the conflict

FOLLOW UP/REINFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES (re-teaching, modeling, demonstrating, show knowledge)

Ask students if they used an "I" statement throughout the next week
